The City of St. Paul Parks and Recreation Department is in the process of developing a Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) for Como Regional Park. The objective is to create a TIP that will be used in planning future transportation improvements for the park.

The project team has gathered data and collected input on transportation-related issues and concerns within the park and surrounding neighborhoods. At this point, primary issues have been identified and the project team, in partnership with the Project Advisory Committee (PAC), has brainstormed potential transportation solutions for the park. The process of concept evaluation has started, and the project team would like public input as it moves forward into developing the final recommendations that will become part of the TIP. The public is invited to learn more about project status and discuss potential solutions at an upcoming public open house:
